### Bridge of Hope BuxMont

Since 1989, Bridge of Hope's program model has been implemented to end and prevent homelessness for single mothers and their children.

Today, 23 Bridge of Hope locations are active in 13 states across the country. After 30 years and national growth, Bridge of Hope's mission distinctive remains the same: engaging Christian faith communities in ending and preventing family homelessness through neighboring relationships that demonstrate Christ's love.

### Literacy Council of Norristown

The Literacy Council of Norristown was founded in 1984 by a group of dedicated Montgomery County citizens, led by Katharine Dosch, to provide tutoring to students who wanted to earn their high school equivalency or improve their reading and math skills.

Since then LCN has grown to meet the increasing need for our programs and services. LCN has added community based literacy projects and continues to grow to meet the needs of the Norristown and greater Montgomery County communities.
